Western Australian quarantine laws are intended to protect this State from imported pests and diseases.

All Potential carriers must be declared to Quarantine WA including:

Fruit & Vegetables
Plants & Plant products
Nuts & Seeds
Hay, Straw and Fodder

Honey, Beehives & Products
Used Vehicles & Machinery
Cargo Containers
Animals & Animal Skins

Quarantine WA has the legislated responsibility to detain and/or inspect any goods entering the state to prevent the introduction of weeds, pests and diseases not present in WA

WA Import Requirements

All plant material, including, potted plants, cut flowers, bulbs, tubers, seed and fruit and vegetables, being imported to WA must meet certain conditions to be allowed entry. Entry conditions may include treatments and/or certification and includes specific labelling requirements. Certification must be issued by the exporting states quarantine authority or by a business operating under a Quarantine WA approved Quality Assurance Arrangement.

Entry requirements can vary depending on the associated risk. Risk is determined by what pests and disease are present in the state (or area within the state) from which the plants originate, the pests or diseases that may be associated with a particular species of plant, or the risk posed by the plant species becoming a weed.

Conditions of entry can, and do, change from time to time as new outbreaks occur, so it is vital that importers and exporters ensure they are meeting the current entry requirements.
